



NEBULAE 2019

Nebulae is the new space for networking at Doclisboa. It is a group of activities, gatherings, opportunities and people for the advancement of the creation, production and dissemination of independent film.

NEBULA – A diffuse cloud of interstellar dust or gas or both, visible as luminous patches or areas of darkness depending on the way the mass absorbs or reflects incident light or emits its own light. Some nebulae (more than one nebula) come from the gas and dust thrown out by the explosion of a dying star. Other nebulae are regions where new stars are beginning to form.

STATE OF THE ART

In each edition one industry topic will be debated and analysed together with experts. In 2019, in collaboration with Creative Europe Desks MEDIA, the topic will be the distribution of films in educational settings. An afternoon with speakers, discussions and group work, intending to contribute to a wider discussion about the European film market in educational settings.

Go to school: How can docs reach the educational market

A conference and a debate on good practices as far as the educational market distribution is concerned, focussing on documentary film. The session comprises some of the best examples when approaching the school market in Europe, joined by excerpts from one "case study" film and a presentation of the Education Project model at Apordoc – Associação Pelo Documentário. Presented by the Creative Europe Desks MEDIA from Portugal, Germany, Denmark, Norway and Croatia, it brings together Portuguese and international guests openly sharing experiences and knowledge.


